Spread of COVID-19	Spread of Virus	Medium/High (dependant on R rate)	All Users	<ul> <li>Avoid use of the school hire during the week, by keeping all weekday classes on Zoom. Only come in on a Friday evening, after the cleaners have been, to set up for Saturday.</li> <li>Thorough COVID-19 procedure in place to minimise risk of infection including the use of small groups (bubbles) to minimise risk of cross-infection across year groups.</li> <li>No parents/carers allowed on site; collection/drop off points socially distanced.</li> <li>Collection &amp; drop off times to be staggered, to limit numbers on site.</li> <li>Students temperature to be taken before class, and parent to take home if they have a temperature.</li> <li>Students to be taken home in-between classes (if they have a long break) so no unnecessary waiting around.</li> <li>Trained staff in GAPA's COVID-19 procedure to ensure safeguards are in place.</li> <li>No one with COVID-19 or suffering symptoms to be allowed on site (signed declaration and temperature checks).</li> <li>Deep cleaning arrangement with GWS, studios cleaned before our arrival on a Friday; staff to be subject to cleaning protocol which includes regular touch points, bathrooms and deeper changeover cleaning in-between classes.</li> <li>Fixed bubbles to be implemented, to assist more easily with Track &amp; Trace, if needed.</li> <li>Teachers to remain in the same studio throughout the day, to eliminate unnecessary contact with anyone.</li> <li>Avoid entering main school building, only using outside buildings with toilets – PAC, Sports Hall, Bluebell.</li> </ul>	All staff, students and their parents/guardians



				<ul> <li>All indoor spaces used are to be well ventilated.</li> <li>Barres in the PAC need to be kept for GAPA use only – place a covering over them during the week. Teachers to wipe down the barres in-between classes.</li> <li>Teachers to provide their own iPod docks, and will take home afterwards.</li> <li>Students to bring their own towels, matts, and barre coverings</li> </ul>	
Students not following COVID-19 Procedure	Spread of Virus	Low	All Users	<ul> <li>Student's fully briefed on new 'rules' they must follow both before joining and upon arrival at site.</li> <li>Students who are unable to follow procedure asked to leave class.</li> <li>Child-friendly posters and images which remind students of new procedures (i.e. catch it, kill it, bin it. Social distancing. Hand washing etc).</li> <li>Individual assessments and monitored 'trials' for any children with individual support needs that may result in breaking social distancing (i.e. potentially violent children and SEND students).</li> </ul>	All staff, students and their parents/guardians
Teachers not following COVID-19 Procedure	Spread of Virus	Low	All Users	<ul> <li>Teachers fully briefed on procedure before classes begin and every week.</li> <li>Management staff constantly ensure procedure is followed, and contingency plans for teachers who struggle to uphold procedure.</li> <li>Teachers must keep meticulous logs of, and be forthcoming regarding teaching within other settings, so that GAPA can make informed decisions regarding their suitability to teach.</li> </ul>	Staff and Management
Spread of COVID-19 through Physical Activity including dance and high- energy games	Spread of Virus	Medium/High (dependant on R rate)	All Users	<ul> <li>Adhering to government gym guidance that allows 100ft² per person in settings.</li> <li>Mark out individual square metre exercise space with removable wipeclean floor markers.</li> </ul>	Staff and Management



Spread of COVID-19 through Singing	Spread of Virus	Medium/High (dependant on R rate)	All Users	<ul> <li>Increased Social distancing measures implemented (2m+) and mitigate risk by using face visors for teachers &amp; use of bubbles, and screens if needed.</li> <li>Regular rest and water breaks controlling students heart rates and breathing.</li> <li>Hand sanitiser stationed outside and inside each studio, to be used when entering and exiting.</li> <li>Government advice to avoid all singing and chanting so no singing or Musical Theatre classes permitted on site.</li> </ul>	Staff and Management
Spread of COVID-19 through Drama Activity/Shouting	Spread of Virus	Medium/High (dependant on R rate)	All Users	<ul> <li>Government advice to avoid all activity that increases speaking voice above a normal volume</li> <li>We will not be holding Drama classes on site.</li> <li>All teachers will wear a headset &amp; microphone, to negate the need to raise their voices.</li> <li>Children constantly reminded not to raise voices. Students who need behaviour management in this may be asked to leave class.</li> </ul>	Staff and Management
First Aid, Medical or Isolation	Spread of Virus	Medium	All Users	<ul> <li>PPE to be worn if social distancing must be reduced to provide first aid or medical intervention.</li> <li>PPE kit and First Aid kit to be stationed in each studio, so no cross contamination, if medical intervention is needed.</li> <li>All teachers to attend an online First Aid Course.</li> <li>Staff member chaperoning any student needed to be isolated must socially distance and wear PPE.</li> </ul>	Management
Loss of vital staff due to illness	Loss of management capabilities	Medium	Management Staff, All Users	<ul> <li>Internal contingency plans that allow staff to cover responsibilities to ensure smooth running of business.</li> <li>Staff wellness checks and signed declaration.</li> </ul>	Management
Loss of teaching staff due to illness	Lessons cannot go ahead as planned	Medium	Management and Students	<ul> <li>Use of cover teachers and deputies.</li> <li>If cover staff brought in, they will be fully informed of all our Covid-19 Procedures.</li> <li>Management able to cover classes.</li> <li>Classes to be cancelled if suitable cover cannot be found.</li> </ul>	Teachers and Management
